July Highlights

- ESCADV provided shelter to 533 nights of shelter to 20 adults and 20 children in July
- Costs of sheltering in hotel increased 38% over July of 2019
- ESCADV staff answered 14 hotline calls (8 for domestic violence, 1 for sexual assault and 6 for other services [callers can be listed under more than 1 category])
- ESCADV advocates provided over 300 hours of advocacy services
