What if I Have Been Assaulted?

First, get to a safe place

- Call the ESCADV Office at 757-787-1329.
 - In Virginia, you can call the statewide hotline at 1-800-838-8238 to contact the closest rape crisis center.
 - Call someone you trust for emotional support.
- Seek medical attention
 - Do not shower, wash clothing, or comb your hair.
- A PERK (Physical Evidence Recovery Kit) examination can be performed, even if you are unsure about making a report.

REMEMBER:

Sexual assault is <u>never</u> the victim's fault. No one deserves to be sexually assaulted; you are not alone, and help is available. **Call us at 757-787-1329** to learn more about your options.
