- ESCADV provided shelter to 751 nights of shelter to 22 adults and 15 children in August
- Costs of sheltering in hotel increased
 75% over July/August of 2019
- ESCADV staff answered 24 hotline calls (18 for domestic violence, 2 for sexual assault and 5 for other services [callers can be listed under more than 1 category])
- ESCADV advocates provided over 250 hours of advocacy services
